#### **Position Details:**

- Type: Part-time contract with West Metro Water Alliance (WMWA)
- Pay: \$45/hour plus mileage and materials
- Budget: \$20,000 for 2024
- Work Periods: Mainly August-November and March-May

## Job Responsibilities:

#### Teaching:

- Visit elementary schools in Hennepin County (Rogers, Dayton, Champlin, Corcoran, Maple Grove, Brooklyn Park, Brooklyn Center, Osseo, Robbinsdale, Crystal, New Hope, Plymouth, Medina, Medicine Lake, St. Louis Park, Minnetonka, and Minneapolis).
- o Teach one-hour classes focused on water resources to fifth-grade students.
  - Lesson 1: "What is a Watershed and Why do We Care?" Overview of watersheds, pollutant issues, and use the scientific method during a short class experiment.
  - Lesson 2: "The Water Cycle More than 2-Dimensional!" Movement and status of water through the water cycle, including pollution and cleansing.

#### Additional Duties:

- o Attend and table at city events throughout the year.
- Attend monthly WMWA Committee meetings to provide updates and explore new outreach opportunities.
